## SCHEDULE CHANGE POLICY FOR ADVANCED COURSES

Students may request a schedule change within the first 5 days of each new semester. After the first 9 -weeks, a student must remain in the class through the remainder of the semester. Any student who fails the first semester of an Advanced Course may be moved to an appropriate level course for the second semester, with parent and counselor consent.
