

## **PAWS Assembly Guidelines**

A Honor Roll: This is not an average and will be influenced by conduct grades. Any student with a U in conduct will not participate in awards. Students arriving after the start of a 9 weeks can be considered for A Honor Roll if: the student has been enrolled for at least 4 weeks, has all A's, and grades can be verified from the previous school. Honor roll awards will be decided on a case by case basis if no previous grades are available. All A's in every subject, for 9 weeks, will receive a bead for their necklace. All A's for an entire year will receive a medal. Students with a U in conduct will receive an award but will not be able to participate in the assembly.

A/B Honor Roll: This is not an average and will be influenced by conduct grades. Any student with a U in conduct will not participate in awards. Students arriving after the start of a 9 weeks can be considered for A/B Honor Roll if: the student has been enrolled for at least 4 weeks, has all A's and B's, and grades can be verified from the previous school. Honor roll awards will be decided on a case by case basis if no previous grades are available. All A's and B's in every subject, for 9 weeks, will receive a bead for their necklace. All A's and B's for the entire year will receive a medal. Students with a U in conduct will receive an award but will not be able to participate in the assembly.

Perfect Attendance:

Influenced by conduct grades. Any student with a U in conduct will not participate in awards. 6 tardies equals one absence. Students arriving after the start of a 9 weeks can be considered for perfect attendance if: the student has been enrolled for at least 4 weeks, has not missed any days since enrollment, and attendance is verified from the previous school. Any student who has received perfect attendance, for 9 weeks, will receive an award provided by PTO. Perfect attendance for the entire year will receive a medal. Students with a U in conduct will receive an award but will not be able to participate in the assembly.

E's in Conduct All Year: This award is only given out at the end of the year. Any student who has received all E's in conduct (including Music and PE) for the entire year will receive a medal.

**Accelerated Reader Awards:** This award is only given out at the end of the year. Three awards will be given to the top readers in each grade level. The top readers will be tabulated according to the number of points earned and passing average of 70%. Ties will be broken by final averages. A gold medal will be given to 1st place, silver for 2nd, and bronze for 3rd.

**Helper/Club Awards:** These awards will be given out each 9 weeks and recipients will receive a certificate.

<sup>\*</sup>Any student serving ISS during a given quarter will not participate in awards. Any student who has a conduct grade other than a "U" will participate in PAWS. Students can also earn a "U" in conduct even if they do not have an ISS assignment if the teacher has documented multiple classroom level conduct issues.

<sup>\*</sup>Any student that receives an all year award will be able to participate in the all year portion of PAWS even if they have "U" in conduct somewhere during the year, as long as they are not serving a consequence on the day of the awards assembly.
