

Dear Parents and Guardians,

We are excited to inform you about the Supplemental Special Education Services (SSES) grant, a program designed to assist families in purchasing educational goods and services for their children. We have determined that your student/family will likely qualify for the SSES Program.

KEY INFORMATION:

The application will close on March 15, 2024, for this school year.

- The application reopens on Feb. 3, 2025, for the following school year.
- This is a one-time only grant, if you have previously applied for or received an SSES grant, you cannot reapply.

Apply before March 15, 2024 to receive your student's \$1,500 SSES grant.

The **SSES+ Medically Fragile program ends on December 6, 2024**. Families must apply by March 15, 2024. Families of students determined as "Medically Fragile" by their ARD Committees may also qualify for the SSES+ Medically Fragile grant. For more information about eligibility, go to our <u>SSES+ Medically Fragile website</u>.

GRANT DETAILS:

- SSES provides \$1,500 per eligible student.
- SSES+ Medically Fragile provides \$5,000 per eligible student.
- Funds can be used for tutoring, educational services, textbooks, curriculum, or technology devices.

APPLICATION STEPS:

- 1. Visit **SSES.tea.texas.gov** and click on "Apply Today."
- 2. Complete the short application you can follow the instructions to find your student's UID or you can reach out to your child's school to get this 10-digit UID.
- 3. You will receive an immediate notice that your application was received.
- 4. After the application window closes, the SSES team will process your application and send your award decision.

IF AWARDED AN SSES ACCOUNT:

- Access the SSES Marketplace to purchase educational resources or services.
- Complete the account activation within the first 30-days, including logging in and signing the SSES Parental Agreement.
- Spend grant funds before the purse deadline you will receive this date in an email if you have been awarded an account.
