## Site Base - December 8, 2016

- Motion to approve previous minutes from September 22, 2016 (PASSED. Mr. Ware motion / Kim Axtell second)
- Campus Improvement plan review
- Mr. Averett gave an update/review on the goals met or progress made on each EHS campus strategy. Each District Goal and Campus Goal area was discussed. Mr. Averett reported the formative review of the progress of each listed strategy. He explained that while there were some strategies that are marked complete as the strategy has been executed, there were others that have not had any progress as they occur during the second semester or that they have not been addressed as of the date of the meeting.
- Campus Emergency procedures were discussed. Mrs. Graff asked about how EHS would respond if an incident occurred during lunch or during a transition time. Mr. Averett explained that teachers are trained to quickly usher students into their classrooms within seconds of the "Lock Down" command and that in a situation such as the one described that EHS would make every effort to shelter students.
- Using an "app" for online school registrations for parents. And using online registrations. (strategy 5.5). To work with the possibility of a new online reporting/grading system (Skyward). Would like to see a system that would allow parents to be able to review and only make changes as needed.
- Idea was put forth to have "rewards" for 9th/10th grade students to have better attendance.
- Exam exemptions for elective credits
- Rewards for perfect attendance
- Sending attendance survey to students - the committee discussed the use of the perfect attendance parties as an incentive and that for some students, the event does not serve as motivation. The committee agreed that it would be beneficial to receive input from students as to what may motivate them to attend school on a regular basis.
- Mr. Averett thanked the committee for their service - especially those members from our community, businesses, and parents and encouraged them to think of ways in which EHS can improve.
