Site Based Decision Making Meeting Minutes February 24, 2021

Attendance was take by Mrs. Barnett all committee members were present with the exception of Mrs. Newsom.

Principal Queen: Introduced Mr. George our new CIS employee. As testing season is approaching Mr. Queen told about the different tests such as TELPAS, Quarterly, Interim and STAAR. He also stated that we are in good shape to go remote at any given time. He praised the teachers and students for all their hard work and cooperation.

Update from Mr.Queen: Student and Staff safety

Student and Staff safety continues to be our top priority at Lummus. We are well supplied with PPEs. We continue to monitor staff and students needs and make the PPEs readily available. Mr. Queen updated the committee on the projects/grants offered to the staff from Ennis education foundation. He also updated on the past and upcoming drills. He said they have all been very successful. Another update stated was on the Jumpstart Plan that is benefiting so many of our students.

Lummus Campus needs/assessments were reviewed. Lummus will be focusing on forming/creating committees and surveys in preparation for next year's start of school. After school tutoring is in the planning stages and will be implemented March 3rd. Online testing is an option this year as we are moving toward all students to be tested online.

Review of ongoing professional development through our Professional Learning Communities time built into our master schedule is very beneficial to the teachers. Also, Mr. Queen discussed that we will be planning for more PD regarding mental health for our teachers and students. During this traumatic time of Covid, Lummus will be very aware of Mental Health needs for all stakeholders.

Mrs. Edmonds gave a Counselor report. Mr. George - CIS social worker has 86 students on his case load that he is serving. During the winter cold snap 100 coats were given to students who did not have a coat. Each Friday, NTx Food Bank is given to 35 students, for weekend food. During the cold snap Lummus doubled up on giving bags out. Mrs. Edmonds reported that on two days of interim and two days of STAAR the entire campus of 583 students will be testing at the same time.
