- 1. Members present included:
 - a. The second regular meeting of the Carver SBDM was called to order at 5:04 p.m. on December 8, 2016 by Eric Pierce.
 - b. Members present: Sheri Payne (Business Rep), Gabriela Espino (PreK Parent Rep), Heather Stevenson (Kindergarten Teacher), McKenzie Crowell (Kindergarten Teacher), and Eric Pierce (Principal).

- 2. Sheri Payne motioned to approve minutes from previous meeting (10.06.16); Heather Stevenson seconded.
- 3. Campus Accomplishments
 - a. Eric Pierce noted the success of the popcorn fundraiser as a current campus accomplishment.
 - i. 5,000 bags of popcorn had been passed out to families with 2,600 more popcorn bags on order from the company.
- 4. Review and approve the campus improvement plan (CIP)
 - a. Eric Pierce began review of the CIP. The new teacher evaluation system (T-TESS) was explained.
 - b. There was a discussion of the instructional materials budget; thus far, Carver ECC has spent approximately \$10,000 on supplies for the classroom including large technology purchases of ESGI and Dreambox programs for teachers and students.
 - c. Eric Pierce announced we have received \$29,000 from the Pre-K grant that will help build a gross motor lab for Pre-K students.

- f. McKenzie Crowell, Heather Stevenson, and Eric Pierce shared information about safety drills that have previously occurred.
- g. Members discussed current parent involvement at Carver ECC. Eric Pierce noted PTO is doing well and the 9 weeks Awards have several in attendance. It was decided that Carver ECC needs more consistent parent volunteers throughout the week.
- h. Eric Pierce discussed the possibility of a 'Campus Preview Day' during the summer to introduce the community and future parents to the campus.
