- Principal is chairperson, Assistant Principal is Co-Chairperson
- Voting of Laurie Butler to hold the secretary position
- One of the duties of the CIP is to discussed/determine how the campus plan ties to the budget needs. We have multiple funding choices when decisions concerning resources or professional development needs come up.
- Review and make updates and changes to our campus plan.

- 30 hours of staff PD in addition to district requirements
- Pre-K Family engagement plan shows what we do to meet these requirements. Everyone got a copy.
